

Friday, January 5, 2018 – 7 pm

As of 7 pm Friday -

Not much has changed since this morning's update. (See this morning's update below for additional details)

- The National Weather Service (NWS) has issued a Wind Chill Advisory until 10am Saturday. Expect wind chills from 0 to -10 degrees overnight. The cold wind chills can cause frostbite in as little as 30 minutes to exposed skin.
- Temperatures will be very cold tonight - forecast lows range from 2 to 5 degrees (wind chills up to -9) across IOW. Temperatures Saturday night will likely be several degrees colder than tonight, we could see zero to below zero temps Saturday night. Winds will be calmer Saturday so wind chills will be comparable to tonight.
- Dominion Energy has restored power to the large area of Battery Park, Rescue, Carrollton and Smithfield without power earlier today. Currently Dominion is reporting 1 customer in Carrollton without power with an estimated restoration time by 9pm tonight. Community Electric reports no outages.
- VDOT has continued to work on the roadways all day today. While conditions are improving, most of the secondary roads remain hazardous. With the cold temps. tonight, continue to encourage everyone to stay off the roads if possible.
