

Monday, January 1, 2018 – 7:00 pm

A quick heads up about likely accumulating snow fall Weds. into Thursday from a coastal weather system moving up from our south. The National Weather Service (NWS) is currently forecasting 2-4" across Isle of Wight. Should the system shift further westward, there is a possibility for higher accumulations.

Based on information from NWS, 2-4" of snow is expected across the lower Eastern Shore south into Hampton Roads and interior northeast NC from Wednesday afternoon into Thursday morning. Lesser amounts of up to 1" are expected along the I-95 corridor, with little to no accumulating snow across the Piedmont. Amounts may be a little lower from VA Beach southward into coastal northeast NC where a changeover to rain should occur for a time Wednesday afternoon/evening.

Travel will become hazardous Wednesday night into Thursday morning with temperatures mainly in the 20s. Gusty winds on Thursday may cause blowing snow and reduced visibility in areas that receive the most snow.
