Quick update this morning, still waiting for the critical turn northward to occur. Most of southeast Virginia remains in the forecast cone this morning. A track off shore along the outer banks remains the favored possibility of the NHC, but anywhere in the forecast cone is a possibility. Nearly all of the forecast models support a near coast track or further off shore (e.g. not supporting a run through NC and over Va). However, due to the sheer size of the storm and the uncertainty in the track until it makes the northern turn, you should continue to work on the assumption that we need to be prepared for potential impacts Thursday/Friday.

The NHC currently has a near 100% chance for tropical force winds and 20% chance of hurricane force winds for Hatteras. Norfolk currently has a 20-30% chance of seeing tropical force & a 3% of hurricane force winds.
