

Tuesday, January 2, 2018 – 9:21 am

Isle of Wight is currently under a Winter Storm Watch for Weds. and Thurs. The National Weather Service (NWS) has increased the most likely forecast accumulation amounts for IOW - we will likely see from 4-6" in IOW . There is currently about a 20% chance that we could see 8" or more. There is a chance snow could begin by mid-day Weds. and is likely by 7pm. The snow chances begin to taper off by around 7am Thursday morning and will likely be over by early afternoon.

Travel is expected to become hazardous late Wednesday night into Thursday morning with temperatures mainly in the 20s. Gusty winds on Thursday may cause blowing snow and reduced visibility in areas that receive the most snow.

*A Winter Storm Watch have been posted for much of eastern VA/NE NC and the Lower Maryland eastern shore for Wednesday and Thursday *

A coastal low is expected to bring accumulating snow and gusty winds to portions of eastern VA, northeast NC, and the lower MD Eastern Shore Wednesday afternoon into Thursday.
