Meeting Call to Order: Mayor VeHaun called the meeting to order.

- I. Public Hearing on the Matter of Accepting a Portion of a Road into the Municipal Street System. Public Hearing closed with no comment at 7:13.
- II. Consideration of a Resolution Accepting a Portion of a Road into the Municipal Street System. Alderman Angel made a motion to accept said road into the municipal street system. Alderman Honeycutt seconded and all voted unanimously.
- III. Consideration of a Code of Ethics Policy. Town Administrator Jason Young gave a review of the policy to the Board. Alderman Bryson made a motion to accept the policy as presented. Alderman Angel seconded and all voted unanimously.
- IV. Consideration of a Contract to Enter into a Grant with the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources. Jason Young presented the Board with the contract which stipulates the Town fund \$35,000 of the greenway project in addition to the \$75,000 presented by the DENR Grant. Alderman Angel made a motion to accept the grant as presented. Alderman Honeycutt seconded and all voted unanimously.
