Meeting

Meeting Call to Order: Mayor VeHaun called the meeting to order.

Invocation: Alderman Honeycutt led the invocation.

Approval of the Agenda: Alderman Giezentanner made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Alderman Bryson seconded and all voted unanimously.

Approval of the Minutes: Alderman Angel made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Alderman Lunsford seconded and all voted unanimously.

Public Forum-*Citizens may address the Board concerning various topics after being recognized by the Mayor.*

Walt Brewer inquired if the Town had any mechanism to remove abandoned mobile homes.

Cathy McDowell of Dog House Day Care alleged that the neighbor whom complains over the dogs barking has been harassing her employees and acting aggressively toward her.

New Business

1. Presentation of a Check to the Woodfin Youth League to Fund Activities for the Upcoming Fiscal Year. Mayor VeHaun presented a check to the treasurer of the Woodfin Youth League.
2. Consideration of a Resolution Establishing the Date for a Public Hearing on a Proposed Sign Ordinance. Alderman Giezentanner made a motion to establish the Public Hearing for October 15. Alderman Lunsford seconded and all voted unanimously.
3. Consideration of an Ordinance Restricting Parking on Municipal Property. Jason Young explained that parking places at municipal properties are being used as overflow parking and base for bicycling trips. Alderman Lunsford made a motion to approve the ordinance. Alderman Hensley seconded and all voted unanimously.
4. Presentation by Mike Griffin on a Proposed Shingle Recycling Facility. Mr. Griffin explained the operations of his proposed shingle recycling facility to be located on property directly adjacent to Silver-Line Plastic to the Board. Operations are currently held at 402 Old Leicester Highway.

Reports

Police: Brett Holloman presented the monthly numbers to the Board and presented material provided by Law Publications.

Public Works: Jason Young presented the Board with the monthly numbers and the Street Light Audit from Duke Energy.

Storm Water Report: \$16,000 dollars in damage has been reported to the State due to recent storm events.

ABC Report: Jason Young stated that the monthly numbers for the ABC were not available for the meeting and would be provided next month.

Administration: Jason Young presented a signage complaint which had been submitted to staff.
