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**Grant Project Ordinance for the Town
 of Woodfin's American Rescue Plan Act of 2021:
 Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds**

Ordinance Number 2022-050401

Date: Tuesday, April 5, 2022

WHEREAS, the Federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) includes substantial aid for state and local governments.

WHEREAS, on May 10, 2021 the US Treasury formally launched the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund established under the American Rescue Plan Act; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Woodfin is considered a non-entitlement local government and as such will receive funds under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 from the State of North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the Act sets aside an estimated \$340,956,000 in grant funding for non-entitlement municipalities in the State of North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Woodfin (Town) has received the first tranche in the amount of \$1,070,345.37 of CSLFRF funds. The total allocation is \$2,140,690.73, with the remainder to be distributed to the Town within 12 months; and

WHEREAS, a Grant Project Budget Ordinance 2021-170801 was adopted on August 17, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Officer and the Town of Woodfin Board of Commissioners wish to amend the budget to reflect new spending guidelines issued by the US Treasury in its Final Rule released in January 2022, and whose provisions are effective April 1, 2022.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE WOODFIN BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT, pursuant to Section 13.2 of Chapter 159 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, the following grant project ordinance is hereby adopted::

Section 1: This ordinance will reverse the budget established in the previous ordinance 2021-170801 amending the amounts previously adopted as follows:

Section 2: This ordinance will further establish a budget for a project to be funded by the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal

Recovery Funds of H.R. 1319 American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP/CSLFRF). These funds may be used for the following categories of expenditures, to the extent authorized by state law.

1. Support public health expenditures, by funding COVID-19 mitigation efforts, medical expenses, behavioral healthcare, and certain public health and safety staff;
2. Address negative economic impacts caused by the public health emergency, including economic harms to workers, households, small businesses, impacted industries, and the public sector;
3. Replace lost public sector revenue, using this funding to provide government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue experienced due to the pandemic;
4. Provide premium pay for essential workers, offering additional support to those who have borne and will bear the greatest health risks because of their service in critical infrastructure sectors; and,
5. Invest in water, sewer, and broadband infrastructure, making necessary investments to improve access to clean drinking water, support vital wastewater and stormwater infrastructure, and to expand access to broadband internet.

Section 3: The Town has elected to take the standard allowance, as authorized by 31 CFR Part 35.6(d)(1) and expend all its ARP/CSLFRF funds for the provision of government services.

Section 4: The following amounts are appropriate for the project and authorized for expenditure:

Section 6: The Finance Officer is hereby directed to maintain sufficient specific detailed accounting records to satisfy the requirements of the grantor agency and the grant agreements, including payroll documentation and effort certifications, in accordance with 2 CFR 200.430 & 2 CFR 200.431 and the Town's Uniform Guidance Allowable Costs and Cost Principles Policy.

Section 7: The Finance Officer is hereby directed to report the financial status of the project to the governing board on a quarterly basis.

Section 8: Copies of this grant project ordinance shall be furnished to the Budget Officer, the Finance Officer and to the Clerk to Town Board of Commissioners.

Section 9: This grant project ordinance expires on December 31, 2026, or when all the ARP/CSLFRF funds have been obligated and expended by the Town, whichever occurs sooner.
