

Solar Permit Applications Received by the Community Development Department

The Village of Woodridge is committed to encouraging solar energy development, and recently Target at 2333 63rd Street started work to install a rooftop photovoltaic system (solar panels). The Target solar system will contain 1,598 panels when crews complete the installation. Last August, Woodridge received a Gold designation from the national SolSmart program for making it faster, easier, and more affordable for homes and businesses to generate solar energy.

The Gold designation recognizes Woodridge for taking bold steps to encourage solar energy growth and remove obstacles to solar development. Woodridge is experiencing extraordinary growth with the number of solar permits. In 2017, Woodridge received four solar panel applications; in 2021, Woodridge received 38 applications. As of July 2022, the Woodridge Community Development approved – or is in the process of reviewing – 30 solar panel applications.

Municipalities make changes to their local processes to reduce the time and money it takes to install a solar energy system to receive the Sol Smart designation. The process improvement includes evaluating local permitting processes and planning and zoning procedures.

Woodridge School District 68 will hold walk-in registration for new & returning students for the 2022-23 school year on Thursday, July 28 from 1:00-6:00pm. All students are to register at Thomas Jefferson Junior High School, 7200 Janes Avenue.

information on the following: important dates, returning students, new students, kindergarten, preschool, residency information, registration fees, and health requirements.



## **DuPage extends low-income household water assistance program**

DuPage County Community Services is continuing to accept applications for the Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP) to assist income-eligible households with their water and wastewater fees.

Residents can call or email to set up an appointment beginning July 1, 2022. The program will run through Aug. 31, 2023, or until funds are depleted. Applications are taken on a first-come, first-serve basis by appointment only. Income-eligible homeowners and renters may receive one-time assistance to

help with water and wastewater bills, reconnection of water service, and other services.

To be eligible, DuPage County residents must have received a disconnection notice, are currently disconnected, or owe \$50 or more, have a household's combined gross income for the 30 days prior to application (gross income for all household members, before taxes are deducted) is at or below 200% of the federal poverty level. 
