Village offices closed on Labor Day

Village offices will be closed Monday, Sept. 5, in observance of the Labor Day holiday. Also, garbage pick-up is delayed by one day according to the holiday schedule. The Monday trash collection is now on Tuesday. The Tuesday collection is now on Wednesday. The holiday does not impact any other collection days.

What day will my garbage be picked up during the Labor Day holiday week? Please see the graphic below.



Also, save the date for Woodridge Clean Up Day October 3 – 7 (depending on your garbage collection day). On your regular collection day during the week of October 3 to 7, residents are permitted to dispose of an unlimited amount of refuse, furniture, carpeting, bulky items, and just plain junk. All items must be properly bundled, bagged, and otherwise prepared for pick-up as they would on any regular collection day. A total of 5 stickers are required and must be displayed (garbage cans included) on items that you would normally tag. All five stickers can be placed on one item, such as the garbage can. Any additional items will be picked up without stickers. Remember that often people will come through town in advance of Groot to take items they would like to repurpose, so please avoid placing stickers on items that might get taken prior to the Groot collection.

DuPage County Health Department launches lifesaving narcan vending machine

The DuPage County Health Department (DCHD) is opening the county's first Narcan vending machine at the Linda A. Kurzawa Community Center (LKCC), located at 115 North County Farm Road in Wheaton. The Narcan vending machine is part of DCHD's efforts to reduce opioid-related overdose deaths by strategically expanding access to Narcan nasal spray. The new vending machine is easily accessible to all community members in the main lobby of the LKCC, which is the location for DCHD's Substance Use Disorder Treatment and Recovery Services.

"DuPage County has been working to save lives and prevent opioid overdose-related deaths through the DuPage Narcan Program (DNP) since 2013," said Dr. Richard Jorgensen, DuPage County Coroner. "For years we prioritized increasing access, training, and awareness of Narcan in DuPage, and this new vending machine is an exciting step forward."

The last day to register to vote, in-person, at Village Hall for the November 8, 2022, election will be Tuesday, October 11. There are also options to register to vote, including online, through the DuPage **County Election Division**

website, dupageco.org/election.

The DuPage County Election Division also has information on how to acquire a mail-in ballot and information on early voting locations. For those planning to vote in-person on Election Day, November 8, you can use the Community Portal website to search for your address and determine your precinct and polling location under the "government representatives" tab.



CONSUMER ALERT: ComEd, BBB report another rise in mobile payment app scams following summer heat wave

Reports show that there has been increase in mobile payment scams. Here's what you should know.

ComED will never call or come to your home or business to:

sell you electricity

ask for immediate payment with a prepaid cash card, third-party banking app like Cash App, Zelle, Venmo, QuickPay, or

cryptocurrency such as Bitcoin

- ask for your account number or other personal info such as a social security number
- ask to see your energy bill
