

It's all included in the cost of your permit and assures your project is done correctly and to current building codes. Open permits without final inspections will hold up the sale of your home, and transfer stamps will not be issued. Don't let this happen; get your final inspections and your permit closed. Statewide Indoor Mask Mandate

Governor Pritzker announced earlier this week that the state is instituting an indoor mask mandate for all Illinois residents, regardless of vaccination status, which will go into effect Monday, August 30. Regarding outdoor mask use - while not required, masks are strongly encouraged in crowded outdoor settings like festivals and concerts as well as for activities that require close contact with people who are not vaccinated.
