April 6, 2021 Consolidated General Election

The Tuesday, April 6, 2021 Consolidated General Election is the opportunity for Woodridge residents to make their selection for the Mayor of the Village of Woodridge, three Village Trustees, and the Village Clerk. Also, there will be a non-binding advisory referendum regarding adult-use cannabis.

Non-Binding Advisory Referendum

A non-binding advisory referendum is an opportunity for the Village of Woodridge to request input and feedback from Woodridge residents on their opinion regarding a specific issue; however, the information is advisory in nature and does not require the Village Board to take action one way or another. The referendum is being asked specifically to understand the community's perspective allowing the retail sale of adult-use cannabis at a dispensary business within the Village of Woodridge. The question will appear on the ballot as follows:

Shall the Village of Woodridge allow the retail sale of adult use recreational cannabis products at dispensary businesses licensed by the State of Illinois?

Plan Commission Meeting Monday, April 5 To Consider Three Cases

The next meeting of the Village of Woodridge Plan Commission will be held on Monday, April 5, 2021 at 7:00 pm. The meeting will be held via Zoom Webinar. The purpose of the meeting is for Plan Commission consideration of three cases: a request for site plan approval, rezoning and a special use permit to build a Bank of America building at 7500 Lemont Road; a request for an expanded parking area at Town Centre located at Plaza Drive, and an amendment to the CVS at 8645 Woodward to accurately reflect changes to their lot resulting from land acquisition by DuPage County. Village Board Approves Future Police Department / Public Works Facility Site Plan

In March 2021, the Village Board was provided an update on the Village's ongoing facilities improvement project. As part of Phase I, the Village Board provided direction to move forward with the Master Plan site option, placing the Police Department on the western portion of the property, while nestling the Public Works salt and cold storage buildings closest to I-355. The targeted estimated budget for this project is \$30.6 million, and will be primarily financed with GO bonds. The next step will be to proceed with full building design and site development, as well as issuance and approval of the bond financing. Under the current project timeline, the Village expects to break ground in Spring 2022. Woodridge School District 68 Back to In-Person School Starting Wednesday, April 7 - Safety Reminders

Woodridge School District 68 is returning to in-person learning, 5 days a week, starting on Wednesday, April 7. As such, please remember these key school safety reminders. Expect an increase in traffic and remember it is unlawful to pass stopped school buses. Please watch your speed in school zones, and note that schools zone speed limits may change in hours and rates; and remember to stop when directed to do so by school crossing guards.

Yard Waste Reminders: Collection Begins April 1 and No Leaf Burning Allowed

Yard waste collection officially resumes on April 1 and continues through December 15. Residents can dispose of yard waste at the curb on their normal refuse collection day. One sticker is required for every 33 gallon unlined container or yard waste paper bag. Brush should be packaged in bundles no more than 4 feet in length and 2 feet in diameter. Each bundle must have a yard waste sticker attached and cannot weigh more than 50 pounds. Also, as a reminder,

the Village does not allow residents to burn leaves or other yard waste. Please dispose of yard waste properly.

Do you have a student eligible for kindergarten attendance for the 2021-22 school year? If so, mark your calendar for Woodridge School District 68's kindergarten pre-registration to be held on Wednesday, April 14 from 3:30 to 7:00 p.m. Register at your child's [home elementary school](#).

Parents are encouraged to complete the [online portion](#) of pre-registration beginning Wednesday, April 7 and prior to the event on April 14. Children currently enrolled in the blended preschool program need not attend, but will need to complete returning student registration. Children must be five years of age on or before September 1, 2021, and the student's birth certificate must be presented.

ComEd Adds \$9 Million in Bill Assistance and Extends Payment Plans to Help Customers Struggling with Electric Bills

On March 18, 2021, ComEd [released a news release](#) stating that ComEd is increasing financial assistance funding by \$9 million to help customers regain their financial footing due to many Illinois families continuing to be adversely affected by economic challenges resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic. The package includes a bill payment assistance program, enhanced payment arrangement options, and special reconnection programs for eligible customers. DuPage County Public Hearing To Obtain Input on 2019 Action Plan Substantial Amendment #5 on Wednesday, April 14

DuPage County received approximately \$6.7 million in Community Development Block Grant-Coronavirus Act Funds and is proposing a 5th Substantial Amendment to its 2019 Action Plan. DuPage County Health Department Accepting Applications for Contract Tracers Through workNet DuPage

DuPage County Health Department through [workNet DuPage](#) is accepting applications for individuals to work remotely as a contact tracer and assist with the COVID-19 crisis. Positions are anticipated to last through December 2021 and the pay is \$21/hour. Contact tracing jobs through workNet DuPage are grant funded. To be eligible, candidates must have directly or indirectly lost employment or wages due to COVID-19 and individuals on furlough can qualify.
