PROPOSED BUDGET**








Reminder: Woodridge Police Department Citizen's Police Academy Accepting Applications

DuPage County Adopts Long Range Transportation Plan

The DuPage County Board voted unanimously Tuesday to adopt its Long Range Transportation Plan guiding transportation investments through 2040.

The Long Range Transportation Plan, known as DuPage Connects, will govern transportation policies and practices at the County for the next 20 years. The \$1.6 billion plan creates a vision and mission for the DuPage County Division of Transportation, serving as a guide for infrastructure maintenance, operations, and capital projects.
