

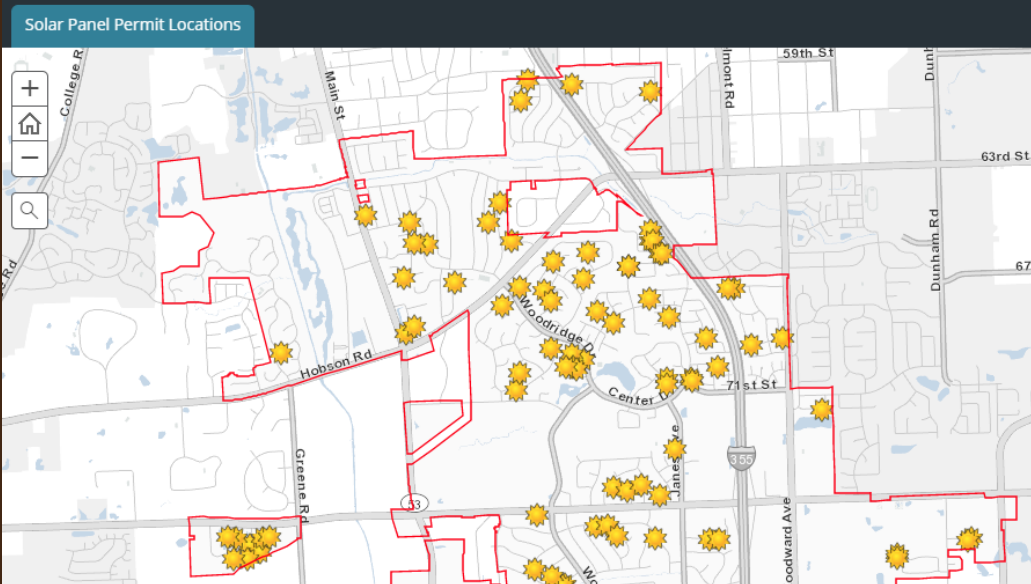

Free Summer Meal Program

Woodridge School District 68 is hosting a free summer meal program for all school-aged children 18 years old and younger. Meals can be picked up on Tuesdays & Thursdays now through July 29 between 10:00am-Noon at Meadowview School (2525 Mitchell Drive) or William F. Murphy School (7700 Larchwood Lane). Families can pick up meals at either of these schools, regardless of which school students attend.

Meal packs will include three boxed breakfasts and three boxed lunches, including milk, that meet all nutritional requirements of the USDA National School Breakfast and Lunch Programs. [Menus and nutritional information](#) are posted in the Food Services section of the [district website](#).

Families will only need to indicate how many children are in the household when picking up meals; no student names or ID numbers will be collected. There is no charge for these meals, regardless of pay status (free, reduced, or paid).

Hydrant Exercising North of 75th Street Starts Week of June 14

The Public Works Department will be exercising and inspecting fire hydrants located north of 75th Street beginning the week of June 14. These activities will take approximately three weeks to complete, weather permitting. This process removes accumulated deposits in the watermain and, as a result, residents may temporarily experience some discolored water. If this occurs, simply run the cold water until the line clears. Signs will be posted in the area that is going to be flushed. Refuse, Recycling and Landscape Waste Contract - Groot Industries

The Village wants to remind you of some information as it relates to Groot and the Groot contract. Currently, the Village is in the fourth year of a five-year contract with Groot Industries to provide a volume based, sticker collection program for single-family residential (and multi-family residential of four units or less). Stickers are increasing ten cents (\$0.10) to \$3.80 per sticker for year 4 (June 1, 2021 to May 31, 2022) and are used for both refuse and landscape waste. Residents also have the option to subscribe to a monthly contract for cart service with Groot by contacting Groot at (888) 485-0900. Additionally, residents should call Groot with any issues related to missed pick-ups, concerns, or questions.
