
To Update Woodridge's Zoning Code





The Village of Woodridge is updating its zoning ordinance, which was adopted in 1976 and updated in 1991. While amendments have been made occasionally, this is the first comprehensive update. Zoning is the main regulatory tool used by local governments to manage the use and form of development on private property. The ordinance update will happen over the course of one year, with a goal completion date of late 2022. *Please visit the Woodridge Zoning website for more information and to share your ideas!* 

# Upcoming DuPage DOT Construction May Impact Woodridge Residents: $87^{\hbox{th}}$ Street & Boughton Road Project



The DuPage County Department of Transportation (DOT) plans to start a road construction project around April 18 that may affect Woodridge residents due to traffic disruptions. Project details:

- The project will add a dual-left turn lanes on the west, east and south legs of the intersection of 87<sup>th</sup> Street/Boughton Road
- Also, 87<sup>th</sup> Street/Boughton lanes will go from four lanes to six lanes through the intersection with Woodward Ave.
- DuPage County DOT expects to complete the project by Nov. 30, 2022

The County will be putting out message boards about a week before construction starts. Pictured are some of the engineering plans for the project. Woodridge Businesses: SBA Loan Deadline is April 18



The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) is reminding small businesses in Illinois that April 18 is the filing deadline for federal Economic Injury Disaster Loans (EIDLs) due to the tornado on June 21, 2021. The loan amount can be up to \$2 million with interest rates of 2.88 percent for small businesses and 2 percent for private nonprofit organizations, with terms up to 30 years. Do you have a student eligible for kindergarten attendance for the 2022-23 school year? If so, mark your calendar for Woodridge School District 68's kindergarten pre-registration to be held on Wednesday, April 6 from 3:30-7:00pm.

Register at your child's home elementary school. Children currently enrolled in the blended preschool program need not attend, but will need to complete returning student registration. Children must be five years of age on or before September 1, 2022, and the student's birth certificate must be presented.
