Update: Woodridge Electrical Aggregation

Due to recent changes in the power market, Eligo has made the decision to move some ratepayers from Eligo to ComEd ELIGOENERGY

Eligo has made the decision to move some ratepayers from Eligo to ComEd. As it is, because of issues with the timing of bill cycles and the expiration of the old Constellation agreement, some customers will first receive a letter from ComEd stating that they are being moved to Constellation, and then will receive a letter stating that they are being moved to ComEd.

What is electric aggregation?

Since 2009, Illinois state law allows municipalities to arrange for the provision of electricity to residential and small commercial retail customers by alternative electric suppliers (i.e. suppliers other than ComEd). This process is known as electricity load aggregation.

Electricity is still delivered by ComEd, which remains responsible for customer service, such as billing and outage response.

Woodridge received a Tree City USA Growth Award by the Arbor Day Foundation to honor its commitment to effective urban forest management.

Growth Award recognizes major milestones and annual activities in five categories on a point based system to build sustainable community forestry programs over the long term such as: building a team, measuring trees and forests, planning the work, performing the work, and building the community framework.

With the additional recognition of a Growth Award, Woodridge has demonstrated their expediency towards building framework for sustainable urban

forest management. Urban tree plantings help reduce energy consumption by up to 25%, which will reduce general energy costs and help with the overall cooling of the city as well. In addition, members of the community benefit from properly placed trees as they increase property values from 7-20%.

Woodridge Celebrates Administrative Professionals Day on April 27




Woodridge recognized the outstanding work of Village of Woodridge administrative assistants and other support staff on April 27 for Administrative Professionals day.

IDNR recommends halt to use of bird feeders, bird baths through May 31 until spread of avian influenza subsides

SPRINGFIELD – The Illinois Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) today issued updated public recommendations regarding wild birds and the EA H5N1 strain of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) currently impacting some wild and domestic bird species. While HPAI has not been detected in songbird species (passerines), IDNR recommends the use of bird feeders and bird baths cease through May 31, or until HPAI infections in the Midwest subside, especially those that waterfowl may visit. During spring, wild birds will have ample food sources while bird feeders are removed.
