

Storm Spotter Training: June 14 with Sgt. Murray

Are you interested in becoming a National Weather Service Storm Spotter? There's an upcoming training opportunity at the Village of Woodridge led by Sgt. Dan Murray from the Woodridge Police Department.

Description

The National Weather Service (NWS) needs volunteers to provide severe weather reports. Spotters relay their reports to the Weather Service as they see it. Forecasters use this information to track storms and alert the public to

dangerous weather situations. The spotter program is informal. Class attendees will learn about the National Weather Service, tornadoes, thunderstorms, flash floods, high winds, and winter storms. Those who complete the course will receive a training certificate and become a part of the NWS crucial storm observing and reporting network.

Event details

If you enjoy watching the weather and wish to provide a valuable public service, this is the course

for you. Sgt. Dan Murray will lead the class, which will take place on Tuesday, June 14, from 7 p.m. -9 p.m. in the Werch Board Room at the Woodridge Village Hall at 5 Plaza Drive. The class will be both in-person and via Zoom. To register, please RSVP by Sunday, June 12 (please note the RSVP deadline is extended from June 10).

New Groot garbage contract is now in effect

The new Groot contact officially went into effect on June 1. The key items to note include:

- Yard waste collection began on April 1 and will continue through December 15.
- Refuse and yard waste stickers incurred a ten-cent (\$0.10) increase on June 1. The new cost of a sticker will be \$3.90.
- Clean-up week is scheduled for the fall, during the first full week of October on your regularly scheduled pick-up day. In 2022, the clean up week will start on October 3.

The Village has worked closely with the waste collection industry during the past decade to develop and maintain a program that meets the needs of residents and is environmentally responsible. Please see the Groot brochure for more details.



U.S. Forest Service and Illinois Department of Agriculture: spongy moth spraying

In late June, the U.S. Forest Service and Illinois Department of Agriculture will be spraying an aerial treatment in a part of Woodridge to help stop the spread of gypsy moths, now known as spongy moths (lymantria dispar). These moths are one of the most damaging forest and tree pests in the U.S., responsible for millions of acres of defoliation annually.

The product used is a non-toxic mating disruption pheromone that does not harm humans or other living things; rather, the

pheromone makes it difficult for male spongy moths to find female moths, thereby disrupting mating and preventing their spread. If you're in the treatment area, there are no special measures you need to take – this practice is safe and does not pose a danger to people or pets.
