Woodridge Police Department Places 3rd in the Illinois Traffic Safety Challenge!

Congratulations to Officer Phelps and the Woodridge Police Department Traffic Unit for placing 3rd in the in the Illinois Traffic Safety Challenge (ITSC)! The ITSC is a program coordinated by the Illinois Association of Chiefs of Police and maintained by a National Highway Traffic Safety Administration grant that is supported by the Illinois Department of Transportation, the Bureau of Safety Programs and Engineering, and funding from private entities. The program helps agencies demonstrate successes to their government officials, community leaders, and citizens. This is the 5th year Officer Phelps has won this award!



Plan Commission

Rivers Edge by Pulte Home Company, LLC - 6200 Route 53: Request for annexation, a special use permit for a Planned Unit Development, zoning map amendments, subdivision and deviations for 45.16 acres of vacant property in unincorporated DuPage County for a mixed use commercial and residential development. The petitioner has requested this case be continued to September 18, 2023.

GTS Transportation – 11321 Joliet Road: Request for a preliminary site plan for the construction of a new building for a truck repair and sales business, which requires a special use permit. The petitioner is also requesting a map amendment from R-1 zoning to M-1 zoning, and preliminary approval of a lot consolidation.

Water Meter Replacement Program

The Village of Woodridge is implementing a mandatory water meter upgrade program to replace existing water meters and remote readers with a new Fixed Base Automatic Meter Reading System (Smart Meters) in all residential, commercial, and industrial areas. The program will include the replacement of approximately 9,000 meters and will take roughly 6 to 8 months. When it your neighborhood's turn to have water meters replaced, United Water Meters Inc. will notify you by letter and/or door hanger for you to schedule a time to complete the replacement.
