

#### **Plan Commission Update**

On September 18, 2023 the Plan Commission will meet in the Werch Board Room at Village Hall, 5 Plaza Drive, at 7:00 p.m. for the following:

- A Variance request to allow a 435 square foot pool cabana at 1304 Pin Oak Court, requested by Maison Gray Designs LLC.
- A Subdivision request to split 1308 and 1312 Pink Oak Court back into two lots, requested by DJK Custom Homes LLC. The lots had been consolidated from two lots into one in 2022.

- Final RPUD Plat and Site Plan to construct 77 townhomes at 8405 Woodward Avenue, known as Farmingdale Townhomes Subdivision, requested by M/I Homes. Preliminary Plat approval was granted by the Village Board in April 2023.
- A Request for annexation, rezoning, a special use permit for a Planned Unit Development, a Preliminary Plat of Subdivision and deviations to construct 62 duplex units and 48 townhome units, with 3.84 acres reserved for commercial lots, at 6200 Route 53 in unincorporated DuPage County, known as Rivers Edge Subdivision, requested by Pulte Home Company LLC.

Suicide is a serious public health problem that can have lasting harmful effects on individuals, families, and communities. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), suicide is a leading cause of death in the United States. Suicide continues to be a persistent threat to our community members and their families as DuPage County has averaged 94 deaths per year to suicide over the past 5 years according to data from the DuPage County Coroner. Sadly, to date in 2023, there have been a total of 61 deaths by suicide reported in DuPage County. Each one of these deaths is a tragedy and suicide can be preventable through timely intervention. - DCHD's Crisis Hotline The DuPage County Crisis Hotline is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week at (630) 627-1700. Callers can expect staff to provide support and guidance to manage the crisis, explore options, and provide other resources that may further assist them

in resolving the crisis.

- Mobile Crisis Response Mobile Crisis Response in DuPage County is available 24/7 for youth and adults at the location of the crisis and can be accessed at (630) 627-1700. Mobile crisis staff will provide support to manage the crisis, explore service needs, and provide necessary resources.
- Crisis Residential Crisis Residential is a 24/7, 12-bed unit that provides short-term crisis stabilization services for adults in DuPage County. Services can be accessed by calling (630) 627-1700.
