Fire Hydrant & Valve Exercising Program

The Village of Woodridge Public Works Department will be conducting its annual fire hydrant and valve exercising inspection program. These activities will continue through October 2023.



The Village exercises all of its hydrants and main line valves on a regular basis in order to remove any accumulation of sediment and other deposits that exist in the water main to improve the quality of water for the customers and to insure they are functioning properly. Residents may temporarily experience some discolored water and low water pressure. If this should occur, simply remove and clean any aerators. Then run the cold water for at least 5 minutes or until the line clears. The Village will post signs in the immediate area of flushing and valve exercising at least one day prior to these events. 2023 Water Rates

Rates for the Village of Woodridge for all water billed on and after May 1, 2023, are as follows:

Water: \$8.70 per 1,000 gallons

Sewer Maintenance Fee: \$0.90 per 1,000 gallons

Capital Improvement Fee: \$1.10 per 1,000 gallons

Fixed Maintenance Fee: varies by meter size

Water Meter Replacement Program

The Village of Woodridge is implementing a mandatory water meter upgrade program to replace existing water meters and remote readers with a new Fixed Base Automatic Meter Reading System (Smart Meters) in all residential, commercial, and industrial areas.



The program will include the replacement of approximately 9,000 meters and will take roughly 6 to 8 months to complete. When it is your neighborhood's turn to have water meters replaced, United Water Meters Inc. (UMI) will notify you by letter and/or door hanger for you to schedule a time to complete the replacement.

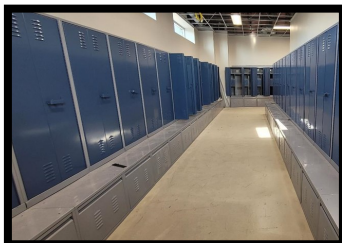


Seasonal Snow Plow Drivers

Warehouse Storage Building is officially fully enclosed with a roof, finished glass, and electrical. Even lockers have been installed! Construction is now focused on landscaping, painting, ceiling tile installation, and flooring.

Annual Woodridge “Clean-Up Day”

On your regular collection day during the first full week of October (10/2—10/6), residents are allowed to dispose of an unlimited amount of refuse, furniture, carpeting, bulky items and just plain junk. All items must be properly bundled, bagged and otherwise prepared for pick-up as they would on any regular collection day.

A total of five (5) stickers are required and must be displayed (garbage cans included) on items that you would normally tag - all five stickers can be placed on one item, such as the garbage can. Any additional items will be picked up without stickers. No stickers are required of residents who use the toter service and are billed directly through Groot.

Building materials, railroad ties, tires, hazardous waste and yard waste are not included in this program. Electronics items (anything with a plug) are prohibited from landfills and cannot be picked up as part of the Clean-Up Day (Amnesty Day) program. If you have any questions, please call 630-719-2905.
