Foundation drain disconnection from the sanitary service and sump pump install	New incentive option	<p>The Village will reimburse 50% of the installation cost, up to a maximum of \$3,000, upon completion, approval and presentation of paid receipts.</p> <p>Building Permit is Required.</p> <p>The program involves the resident contracting with a licensed plumber for removal of the foundation drain and installation of a sump pit. The contractor will need to secure a building permit through the Building/Zoning Department. All work will need to be inspected by Village Inspectors prior to reimbursement.</p>	Incentive from the Village: Max: \$3,000.00	\$3,000 to \$6,000	Eliminates I&I from the sanitary line that can result in back-ups if service line has problems, i.e., roots, offsets, etc.

\*Presence of a foundation drain should be ruled out by a licensed plumber.
