Yard Waste Collection Begins April 1



Yard waste collection officially resumes on April 1 and continues through December 15. Residents can dispose of yard waste at the curb on their normal refuse collection day. One sticker

is required for every 33 gallon unlined container or yard waste paper bag. Brush should be packaged in bundles no more than 4 feet in length and 2 feet in diameter. Each bundle must have a yard waste sticker attached and cannot weigh more than 50 pounds. Sticker costs will also increase by ten (10) cents on June 1, 2023, from \$3.90 per sticker to \$4.00 per sticker.

Residents can also use environmentally friendly alternatives to dispose of yard waste. These options include mulching and composting. Visit DuPage County's website, www.dupageco.org, for information on composting.

Water: \$8.49 per 1,000 gallons Sewer Maintenance Fee: \$0.90 per 1,000 gallons Capital Improvement Fee: \$1.10 per 1,000 gallons Fixed Maintenance Fee: varies by meter size
