Facilities Improvement Update

Construction continues at our new Police Department and Public Works facilities located at 7200 Janes Avenue. Crews have been working to complete the Police Department roofing structure as well as the Public Works Salt Dome and Cold Storage building. Mild winter weather has allowed Harbour Contractors to continue construction keeping the project moving forward. Construction of the interior of the Police Department is expected to continue through the winter months.



Snow Shoveling Tips & Reminders

- When shoveling the end of the driveway near the street, place the snow to the right of the driveway (as you face the street). Snow piled on the left side adds to the amount that can be spread into the driveway.
- On the left side of the driveway (as you face the street), clear a few feet of snow off of the street and curb line.
- Do not shovel snow back into the streets - this causes ice patches which are hazardous to drivers and snowplows.
- Keep fire hydrants on your property clear of snow and ready for use in case of an emergency.



- Keep sidewalks around your residence free of snow and ice.

Ruse Burglaries Prevention Tips

The Police Department would like to make residents aware and to be vigilant of ruse burglary incidents in the surrounding areas. Offender(s) approach a potential victim and claim to be utility workers, Village employees, cable TV technicians or contractors. The offender will then gain entry to the residence using the ruse of checking for alleged problems (water pressure, fuses, wires, pipes, fence line issues, etc.) Once inside the home, the offender(s) will keep the victim distracted or lure them outside of the residence to ask a question. Then one or more additional offender(s) unknowingly enters the home and commits a theft, generally targeting cash and jewelry.

If you ever have a question about the identity or validity of a person at your door, you are encouraged to call 911 immediately. Any legitimate person will gladly wait for the police to arrive to verify their information.

Holiday Light Recycling Through 3/3/23

Woodridge residents may recycle non-working holiday lights at Woodridge Village Hall, 5 Plaza Drive or Public Works building, 1 Plaza Drive. The Village is partnering with Elgin Recycling to offer this free service to residents now through March 3, 2023. Please - no CFLs.



Overnight & Winter Parking Reminders

A reminder that the parking of vehicles on Village streets between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. is prohibited without prior approval. You may submit an overnight parking request online through the Woodridge Police Department website.



Also, in the event of a snowfall that is expected or does exceed two inches, NO overnight parking will be permitted on any village street. Avoiding street parking during a snowfall allows snowplows to have more room to remove snow.

Water: \$8.49 per 1,000 gallons

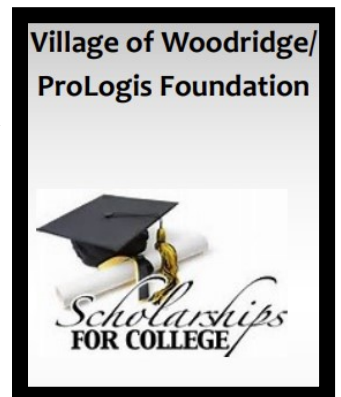
Sewer Maintenance Fee: \$0.90 per 1,000 gallons

Capital Improvement Fee: \$1.10 per 1,000 gallons

Fixed Maintenance Fee: varies by meter size
