# CMAP's Mobility Recovery Report Lays Groundwork to Address Post-pandemic Travel, Transit Changes

The Mobility Recovery report includes recommendations to reimagine mobility and ensure a stronger multimodal system that can ease congestion,

sustain transit, bolster sustainable travel, and better support the region. This two-year effort — supported through extensive research, analysis, and outreach — tracked trends to better understand how our region's transportation needs evolved during the COVID-19 pandemic and identified numerous strategies to address these challenges.

The Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP) developed the report in partnership with more than 20 local governments, transportation providers, transit advocates, and other organizations in northeastern Illinois.

The report identifies solutions that can:

- Invest in a stronger and more financially secure transit system
- Expand travel by safe and active modes
- Balance the benefits and impacts of e-commerce and freight activity

"The pandemic has created new challenges for northeastern Illinois' transportation system and intensified many longstanding disparities," said CMAP Executive Director Erin Aleman. "The Mobility Recovery report provides a blueprint to help people and goods move through our region sustainably and equitably for decades to come." For more information visit www.cmap.illinois.gov.
