The trees must be free of decorations, wire, and lights and not placed in plastic bags. Wreaths and evergreen garland are excluded from the Christmas Tree Recycling Program.

Monday, January 9 marks the final week of the Christmas Tree Recycling Program. Final collection will be on Friday, January 13.

Woodridge residents may recycle non-working holiday lights at Woodridge Village Hall, 5 Plaza Drive or Public Works building, 1 Plaza Drive. The Village is partnering with Elgin Recycling to offer this free service to residents from November 21, 2022, through March 3, 2023. Please - no CFLs.



Electric Vehicle Rebate Program

IEPA is accepting applications for the second round of the Electric Vehicle Rebate Program. Illinois residents who purchase a new or used all-electric vehicle from an Illinois licensed dealer are eligible for a rebate in the following amounts:

- A \$4,000 rebate for the purchase of an all-electric vehicle that is not an electric motorcycle; and,
- A \$1,500 rebate for the purchase of an all-electric motorcycle.

The deadline to apply is January 31. Purchasers must apply for the rebate during the open rebate cycle and within 90-days of vehicle purchase. IEPA has posted additional information on the Electric Vehicle Rebate Program on its website, including the application, eligibility requirements and frequently asked questions ([available via this link](#)).
