The ROW typically includes the sidewalk and the area between the sidewalk and road. Signs placed in the ROW are not permitted and are subject to removal. 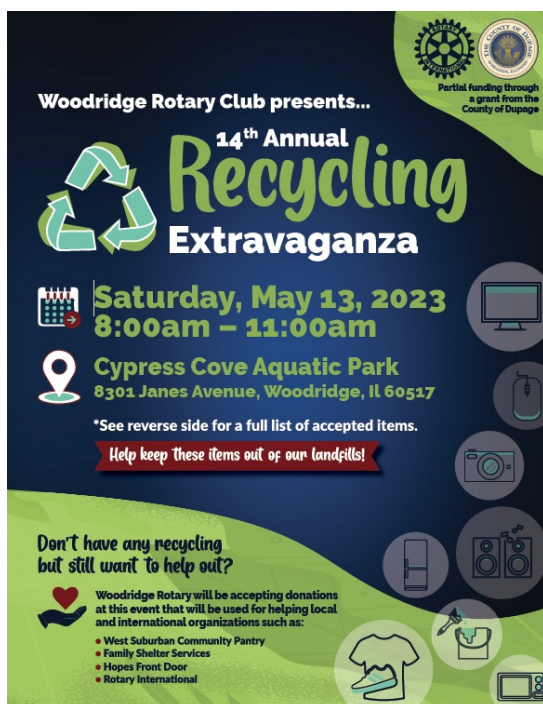

Top 5 Reasons to Host a Food Drive or Diaper Drive

1. We give you the tools to run a successful drive, so it takes the guess work out of planning. Toolkits include printable posters, flyers, and social posts. We even have pre-printed yard signs available to borrow!
2. Food drives and diaper drives are great ways for students to learn the value of volunteering and make a difference in their community!
3. A baby with a clean diaper is a happy baby! Diapers are expensive, and parents struggle to maintain an ample supply for their little ones. Diapers cannot be purchased using the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), so many local parents depend on WSCP for their supply.
4. WSCP gives out 125 lbs of food per family per visit – we can't do that without the generosity of people like you!
5. WSCP serves more than 6,800 individuals each month, and that number is growing. We need help to meet the need!
