Farmingdale Village Townhomes - 8405 Woodward Avenue: Request by M/I Homes for rezoning property from ORI to A-1 Residential District and a major amendment to the McAdams Regional Planned Unit Development, along with other approvals, to construct 77 attached single family townhome units (14 buildings) instead of the remaining 144 condominium units (9 buildings) originally approved for the vacant property located behind the Farmingdale Village Condos at 8405 Woodward Avenue. The applicant, M/I Homes, has formally requested to continue the public hearing meeting. The Plan Commission will convene on March 6, 2023 to open the meeting and vote to continue to a future meeting date.

Pace Passengers Can Ride More for Less as Transfer Fee is Eliminated

ARLINGTON HEIGHTS, IL – Improving regional connectivity is a priority for Pace and its partners at Metra, CTA, and RTA. In addition to the new Pace/CTA unlimited-ride passes and reduced pass

pricing starting Monday, February 20 th, Pace passengers will ride more for less with the elimination of transfers between Pace services. Passengers transferring to Pace premium services will continue to pay a surcharge to get to the premium base fare.

"The elimination of transfer fees improves access for all by making our services more affordable and our fares more equitable," said Executive Director Melinda Metzger. "We will continue to evaluate our fares

and service to meet the needs of those we serve and ensure regional connectivity." Free transfers are valid when using Ventra within two hours of the first trip taken. A Ventra card is free after registration and allows riders to store passes and discounts and save money on each ride.

DuPage County Launches New Website

The DuPage County Board launched its new DuPageCounty.gov website, impacting more than 1.8 million users who navigate the site each year. Visitors search for property records, pay property taxes, request copies of vital records, apply for permits and licenses, watch County meetings, and even view animals up for adoption at the County animal shelter.

Improvements include:

- Streamlined content with redundant information removed, reducing the number of webpages from 1,659 to 963 pages, improving user navigation and search functionality.
- New analytics to help staff better understand the website's audience and traffic patterns.
- Implemented designated accessibility menus for each page of the site, allowing individuals with disabilities to navigate the site more easily.

Those navigating to the site using the old URL, dupageco.org, will be automatically redirected to the new site at www.dupagecounty.gov. The DuPage County Board allocated \$390,000 in federal funds from the American Rescue Plan Act to facilitate the website redesign.

Department of Aging Seeks Nominations for Senior Illinoisan Hall of Fame


