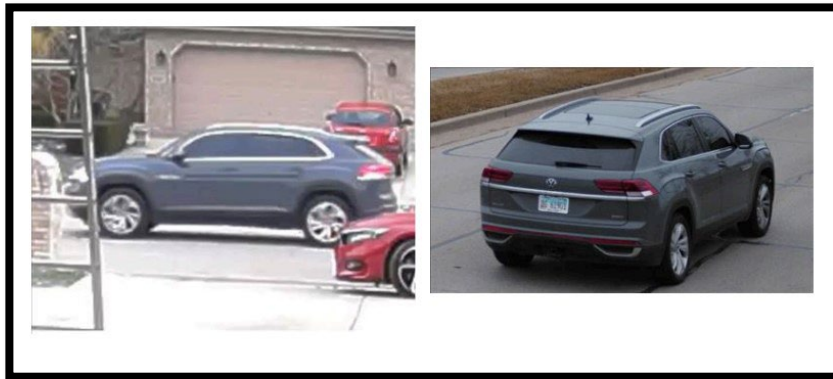

Woodridge Police Department Ruse-Entry Residential Burglary

- Officers responded to a residential burglary on January 7, 2023, at 2:30 p.m.
- Officers learned, one suspect entered the residence posing as a “Water Department employee.”
- Three additional suspect(s) then entered the home and took jewelry.

WOODRIDGE, Ill., January 9, 2023: On Saturday, January 7, 2023, at 2:30 p.m., Woodridge Police officers responded to a Ruse-Entry Burglary in the area of Woodward Avenue and Harcourt Drive. Upon arrival, officers spoke with the homeowner who indicated that a person posing as a “Water Department” employee asked to enter the home. As the subject entered the kitchen, additional persons(s) entered the residence without the owner’s knowledge and removed several items of jewelry. When the homeowner became suspicious, the fake water employee spoke to unknown persons, via cell phone, and all the subjects left the residence.
