Woodridge Police Investigating Armed Robbery at Verizon Store

- Woodridge Police responded to a call about an armed robbery at Verizon (2828 75th St.)
- The two suspects displayed a handgun and stole several phones
- They fled the area in a newer blue model Mazda CX-5

WOODRIDGE, Ill., February 14, 2022: On February 12, 2022, at 9:13 a.m., Woodridge Police responded to the Verizon store at 2828 75th Street for a report that an armed robbery had recently occurred. The caller told officers that two suspects had entered the store and displayed a handgun. The suspects then moved to the back of the store, and they removed several phones. The suspects fled the area in a newer blue model Mazda CX-5.

Suspect #1: Male, Black, approximately 5 feet 9 inches to 5 five feet 10 inches tall, weighing 240 pounds to 250 pounds, wearing light blue jeans, suede brown casual shoes, olive or dark green pleated winter jacket, possible gray hoodie underneath, wearing blue surgical gloves and a white dust mask.

Suspect #2: Male, Black, approximately 5 feet 8 inches tall, weighing 160 pounds to 170 pounds, wearing black sweatpants, black hoodie with white writing on the front and back, white tennis shoes, wearing blue surgical gloves and a black face mask.
