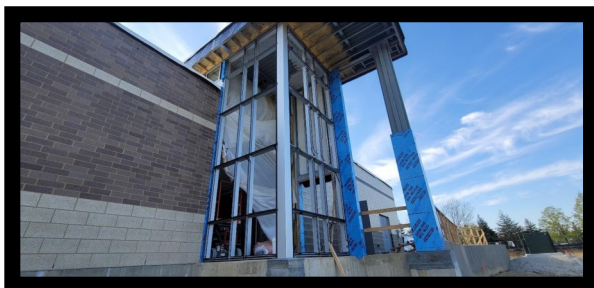
Woodridge Jubilee

Facilities Improvement Update

Construction continues at our new Police Department and Public Works facilities located on Janes Avenue. The Police Department is officially fully enclosed with a roof and finished glass. Construction is now focused on finishing the internal building mechanicals and office and detention space framing which is well underway. The new Public Works warehouse storage building is also advancing with precast walls, roof construction, and internal buildout scheduled over the summer months.

Woodridge Water Quality Report

Residents can view the most current Water Quality Report at www.woodridgeil.gov/waterqualityreport to learn more about your drinking water. This report contains important information about the source and quality of your drinking water.

Construction Hours Between June 1 and August 31

The Village Code contains an ordinance about construction hours, and the new construction hours go into effect starting on June 1.

Between September 1 and May 31

No construction, erection, excavation, or any other process of building whatsoever, shall be performed within the village before the hour of 10 a.m. or after the hour of 5 p.m. on any Sunday, or before the hour of 7 a.m. or after 7 p.m. on any other day. (Ord. 2015-33, 6-4-2015).

Between June 1 and August 31

No construction, erection, excavation, or any other process of building whatsoever, shall be performed within the village before the hour of 10 a.m. or after the hour of 5 p.m. on any Sunday, or before the hour of 7 a.m. or after 9 p.m. on any other day. (Ord. 2015-33, 6-4-2015)

The National Arbor Day Foundation has recognized the Village of Woodridge as a Tree City USA for the 32nd consecutive year! This recognition reflects the Village's continuing commitment and investment to its urban tree canopy.



Waste and Recycling Services Update

The Village wishes to remind residents of a few items related to Groot refuse collection services, including:



- Yard waste collection will continue through December 15.
- Refuse and yard waste stickers will incur a ten-cent (\$0.10) increase on June 1, 2023. The new cost of a sticker will be \$4.00.
- Flat Rate Collection rates will increase from \$24 for the 33 and 64 gallon totes to \$24.50 per month, and from \$27 for the 96 gallon tote to \$28 per month.
- Clean-up week is scheduled for the fall, during the week of October 2, 2023.
- Please don't place your recycling in a bag. Since bagged recyclables cannot be separated and sorted, they will not be collected.

2023 Water Rates

Rates for the Village of Woodridge for all water billed on and after May 1, 2023, are as follows:

- Water:* \$8.70 per 1,000 gallons
- Sewer Maintenance Fee:* \$0.90 per 1,000 gallons
- Capital Improvement Fee:* \$1.10 per 1,000 gallons
- Fixed Maintenance Fee:* varies by meter size
